A child is waiting for you right now


On any given day, thousands of Florida children are unable to **live safely at home** ... at least for a little while.

Children who have suffered extreme trauma often have severe emotional and behavioral needs. Therapeutic foster families complete very specialized training so they are equipped to best help children in their home.

Medically involved special needs foster care

In addition to traditional preparation, foster parents who care for kids in the medically involved special needs foster care program receive specialized training to provide for the unique medical needs of children in their home.

Complete a phone interview

Attend a free orientation

Complete 27 hours of training to learn how to best care for our kids. You'll find out:

- How the foster care system works
- How to access resources for children in your home
- How to engage and support birth families
- How to respect and encourage dignity in children
- How to be the best foster parent you can be

Complete 24 hours of specialized training to become a therapeutic or medical foster parent

Undergo background screenings, employment and reference checks

Complete a thorough home study

Receive your license in about four to six months Start changing lives
