Disciplinary referrals dropped by over 90% between 2016-2020.

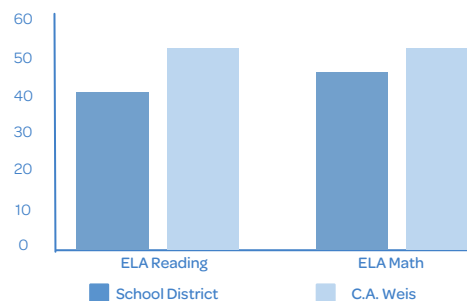
OUT OF SCHOOL SUSPENSIONS
