### Serving Families

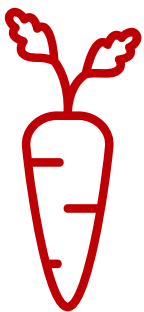
At Wilkinson Jr. High School, we offer something no other school has in the community: A full-time Parent Resource Center which allows you to play an active role in your child's education.
