2024 Legislative Budget Request of \$10.6M Increase Total New Proposed Budget: \$21.6M

Fiscal year 23-24 current budget: \$11M (line item 157A)

We are requesting your support to increase grant funding for the Community Partnership Schools[™] model (Section 1003.64, F.S.). The current legislative appropriation of \$11 million supports the existing 36 Community Partnership Schools and allows 8 additional Community Partnership Schools to begin the planning stage (see map on next page).

Funding Request of \$10.6M

- Increase workload at the UCF Center for Community Schools through data evaluation and technical assistance
- Expand model to 8 new planning sites and secure funding for current planning sites
- Support workforce stability by increasing Community Partnership School coordinator salaries
- Increase additional support for students by funding an additional coordinator at elementary and middle school sites
- Ensure access to behavioral health services for students in every Community Partnership School site

As we advance the Community Partnership Schools™ model and increase positive outcomes for more students and their families, additional funding will provide extra resources to support our schools, opportunities for growth, a competitive and stable workforce, and ensures accessibility to comprehensive behavioral health services for all students.
