Partnership in Action



Mia's struggles with behavior and mental health began when she was in Pre-K. She would have immense anger outbursts at home and school that involved screaming, crying, throwing and breaking items. In 3rd grade, she received 4 out-of-school suspensions for threatening the safety of others. Mia lives with a learning disability, which creates additional communication challenges.

Mia's trajectory began to shift when the Community Partnership Schools™ model allowed for her to begin Counseling and Targeted Case Management. Mia began to meet virtually every week with her clinical counselor to build her confidence, learn about coping skills and find resources to help her reach her goals.

When Mia meets with her counselor, she feels happy, calm and supported. She joined the dance team and has made friends in her class. Mia has grown socially, is encouraging other students, bringing her full circle to empower others to also realize their full potential.

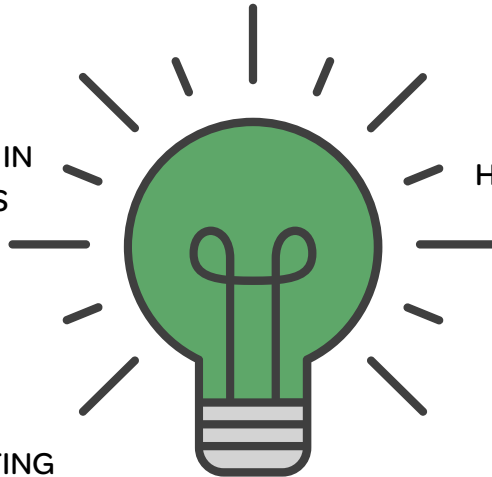

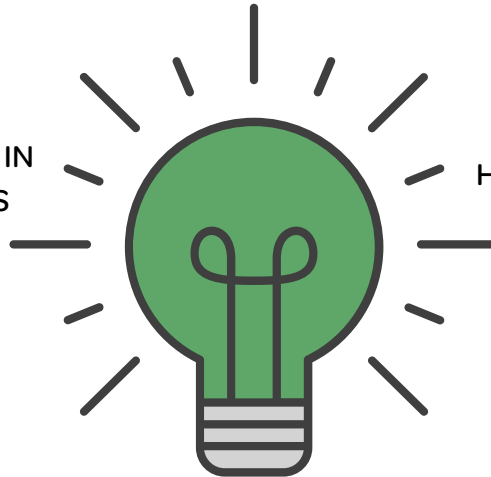
