After transferring to Jones her sophomore year, Amari was navigating the stressful transition of a new school and a rigorous schedule while balancing responsibilities at home. Unable to focus in class and feeling overwhelmed with uncertainty and worry for the future, Amari turned to the Community Partnership School for help, where she received free health and wellness services and learned coping strategies to manage her anxiety.

Amari used the coping skills she learned to remain focused on her grades and to become involved in school through the Student Leadership Council and the CHS Virtual Advocacy Academy. Amari was connected with the tools she needed to succeed, including a lap top and a scholarship to further her education at Florida Southern College where she plans to study Business Management and dreams of owning a dance and photography school.

"I knew someone always had my back and knowing that is a confidence boost," says Amari. "I learned It is OK to ask for help. It is OK to be vulnerable to other people. If you aren't being vulnerable, they can't effectively help you!"
