The Adopt-A-Raider program has blossomed into an annual event that supports our families and engages our school community and partners. Responsive to the needs of our students, families, and community members who need extra cheer and support during the holiday season, the Adopt a Raider program discretely identifies who need support and shares their wish list with someone willing to "adopt" them to fulfill their holiday wishes. At the Adopt A Raider Open House, we open our doors to community members, partners, teachers and staff to celebrate the season and anonymously share the wish lists. Ornaments with wish lists decorated our Christmas tree. Each guest was welcome to pick an ornament and purchase anything on the selected wish list for Christmas. This year, Adopt A Raider was a huge success! Our community showed tremendous support by adopting 76 Orange Park High School Raiders, 44 Future Raiders and 27 Community Members! Donations in the form of gifts and monetary contributions totaled \$27,368.80. The families were so grateful. This was our 3rd Annual Adopt A Raider and it has grown tremendously from the initial year when we had 35 Raiders whose wish lists were adopted for the holiday. This year, as we celebrated 147 "adoptees", we know this would not have been possible without a great partnership with community members and partners who helped our Raider community.
