

WHAT WE DO

We empower families to create safe, strong, solid foundations so their children can grow up in healthy, nurturing homes.

WHY IT MATTERS

Early childhood, particularly the first 5 years of life, impacts long-term social, cognitive, emotional, and physical development.¹

With CHS, more children are safe at home with their families.





In CHS programs statewide, **nearly 100% of families that complete our voluntary home visiting early childhood programs remain safe at home –** and never enter the foster care system.

When families become involved in the child welfare system, we help to ensure kids have safe, stable homes while we help them through their trauma. We also work with parents to overcome challenges that led to the foster care system so they can bring their children safely back home. If safe reunification is never possible, then we find forever families for children through adoption.





Expand a Proven Model to Success: Community Partnership Schools

CHS requested continued funding for existing schools and additional funding to expand the model throughout Florida.

RESULT: In addition to sustaining support for Community Partnership Schools, the legislature authorized increased funding to expand the model to 6 more schools!



Strengthen Families: Healthy Families Program

CHS requested recurring funds to stabilize the workforce serving children and families, ensuring parents have the tools needed to reduce trauma, improve outcomes, and keep their families together.

RESULT: The legislature granted funding to improve workforce stability, helping empower families across Florida. CHS continues to advocate for recurring funds to ensure more families remain strong and together.

Jessica and Brian's story is one of resilience, determination, and the power of support in overcoming life's greatest challenges. After battling addiction, they made the courageous decision to embark on a path of recovery to regain custody of their daughter, Journey. Through perseverance and the support made possible by CHS donors and advocates, they triumphed over adversity and rebuilt their family.

Realizing the impact addiction had on their lives and their family, Jessica and Brian committed themselves to change. They recognized that creating a stable and nurturing environment for for their children would require addressing their addiction, developing healthy coping strategies, and making long-term lifestyle changes.

For the next two years, they worked tirelessly to overcome their personal battles, participating in rehabilitation programs, counseling sessions, and support groups. It was difficult, but their love for their children served as a powerful motivation.

"We would have never gotten Journey back if it wasn't for everybody fighting for us as hard as they did," said Jessica. Through determination and steady support, Jessica and Brian refused to allow any obstacle to threaten their future as a family.

The moment they were reunited with their Journey marked a turning point in their lives. With newfound strength and sobriety, they continued to thrive as a family. They also seized new opportunities and opened their own business, setting the stage for financial stability and independence.

Through their hard work and determination, they created a brighter future not only for themselves but also for their children.

Reflecting on her experience, Jessica's advice to parents facing similar challenges is to keep pushing forward. "Keep doing the right thing, even when you feel like what you're doing is not good enough because it will pay off," she shares.
