

# SUPPORT AN INCREASE IN FUNDING FOR COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP SCHOOLS

2026 Legislative Session Request

## FUNDING INCREASE REQUEST OF \$6.1 MILLION

The Community School Grant Program (Section 1003.64, F.S.) has strengthened the quality of education across Florida. We respectfully request legislative support to increase grant funding for this initiative so it can reach more of Florida's children.

For the 2025-26 fiscal year, the budget of \$20.1 million supports 50 Community Partnership Schools (CPS) statewide. **An increase of \$6.1 million** in grant funding would allow for:

- **Continued step-up and sustainability efforts** of current implementation sites according to Community Partnership School™ model guidelines.
- Investment in the initiative's infrastructure by leveraging data systems to **improve technical support capacity** and **enable real-time, data-driven decision-making**.
- Up to **ten new planning sites** for future Community Partnership Schools.
- Enhancement of student health programs at all Community Partnership Schools, including **access to behavioral health services**.

## WHY THE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS GRANT PROGRAM: COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP SCHOOLS MODEL?

The Community Partnership School™ model has demonstrated success in improving student behavior, increasing academic achievement and graduation rates, and strengthening parental involvement.

Through a collaborative approach, the model positions schools as central hubs for child well-being by addressing key barriers to learning with services such as counseling, medical and dental care, after-school enrichment, mentoring, and more.

By integrating these supports, Community Partnership Schools create learning environments that expand opportunities and increase the likelihood of success for students across Florida.


