

Understanding the complex challenges faced by modern families, CHS introduced early childhood programs, counseling services, and in-home support designed to stabilize and strengthen family units. These initiatives reflect CHS's comprehensive approach to supporting both children and families.

Today, CHS leads with innovative programs like the Community Partnership Schools™ model, partnering with local communities to remove barriers to education and offer holistic support to students and their families.

This approach has transformed educational outcomes in schools across Florida, demonstrating CHS's ability to adapt to the evolving needs of communities.

Throughout its history, CHS has remained dedicated to its mission of empowering children and families to discover and pursue opportunities for success and happiness. Our Programs

Early Headstart

Primarily serving families in poverty, we empower families to create safe, strong, solid foundations so their children can grow up in healthy, nurturing homes.

Nearly 100% of families that complete our voluntary home-visiting early childhood programs remain free from abuse or neglect – and never enter the foster care system.

Healthy Families

Healthy Families is a free, voluntary program designed to support parents in giving their children the best possible start in life. Through regular, in-home visits, our trained and caring Home Visitors offer guidance on child development, positive parenting techniques, and stress management. We help families understand developmental milestones, create safe home environments, stay on track with medical appointments, and connect with valuable community resources. Our goal is to empower parents to set and achieve meaningful goals for themselves and their families while building a strong, healthy foundation for their children's future.

Community Partnership Schools

By addressing barriers to learning—poverty, mental health struggles, homelessness and others – Community Partnership Schools bring together high-quality academic supports, health care, counseling, mentoring and more.

Community Partnership Schools improve student behavior, increase academic gains and graduation rates, and enhance parental involvement, offering equitable learning opportunities for all students.

Targeted Case Management

Targeted Case Management provides personalized support to help children ages 0–17 with emotional, behavioral, or mental health challenges succeed at home, in school, and in the community.

Our case managers work closely with families to develop tailored plans, connect them with critical resources like counseling and evaluations, and build strategies to manage stress, behaviors, and daily challenges—ensuring no family has to navigate these difficulties alone.
